विषय- अक्युपंकचर पदविका अभ्यासक्रम- शैक्षणिक वर्ष २०२४-२५ च्या प्रथम वर्ष द्वितीय सत्रांत परिक्षेच्या संस्था स्तरावरील अंतर्गत मुल्यांकनाबाबत मार्गदर्शक सूचना.

महाराष्ट्र अक्युपंकचर परिषदेतर्फे उक्त अधिनियम तसेच शासनाच्या मार्गदर्शक सूचनांनुसार सन २०२४- २५ या शैक्षणिक वर्षामध्ये महाराष्ट्र राज्यात अक्युपंकचर पदविका अभ्यासक्रम २०२४ पासून सुरु करण्यात आलेला आहे. या पदविका अभ्यासक्रमासाठी महाराष्ट्र शासनाने व आरोग्य विज्ञान विद्यापीठाने मान्यता दिलेल्या पाठ्यक्रमानुसार शैक्षणिक वर्ष २०२४-२५च्या प्रथमवर्ष पदविका अभ्यासक्रमाच्या संस्थास्तरावरील द्वितीय सत्राच्या अंतर्गत मुल्यांकन व सत्रांत (सेमिस्टर) परीक्षा घेणे आवश्यक आहे. परिषदेमार्फत या परीक्षेसंदर्भात वेळापत्रक परिषदेच्या संकेतस्थळावर प्रसिद्ध करण्यात आलेले आहे.

याद्वारे पदविका अभ्यासक्रम सुरु करण्यात आलेल्या संस्थांमध्ये अंतर्गत मुल्यांकन व सत्रांत परीक्षा घेण्याबाबतच्या मार्गदर्शक सूचना खालीलप्रमाणे निर्गमित करण्यात येत आहेत.

अ) अंतर्गत मुल्यांकन-

- शासनमान्य पाठ्यक्रमातील सुचनांनुसार विद्यार्थ्यांनी अंतर्गत मुल्यांकन व लेखी परीक्षा स्वतंत्रपणे उत्तीर्ण होणे आवश्यक आहे.
- अक्युपंकचर चिकित्सा पदविका अभ्यासक्रम सुरु करण्यात आलेल्या संस्थांनी प्रथम सत्रातील विद्यार्थ्यांचे अंतर्गत मुल्यांकन (Internal Assessment)संस्था स्तरावर करण्यात यावे.
- संस्था स्तरावरील अंतर्गत लेखी परीक्षा २० गुणांची असेल. यामध्ये तोंडी परीक्षा, प्रॅक्टिकल, जर्नल, असाइनमेंट, संस्थेने घेतलेल्या इंटरनल लेखी परीक्षा इत्यादीचा समावेश असेल.
- ७५% उपस्थिती असलेले विद्यार्थी सत्रांत परिक्षेला पात्र ठरतील.
- संस्था स्तरावरील अंतर्गत मुल्यांकन परीक्षा आयोजित करण्याचा कालावधी - २६ डिसेंबर, २०२५ ते १० जानेवारी, २०२५ दरम्यान
- अंतर्गत मुल्यांकनाचे गुण परिषदेला अंतर्गत लेखी परीक्षा घेतल्यानंतर लगेच ईमेलद्वारे व हस्तपोच /टपालाद्वारे आठ दिवसांचे आत पाठविण्यात यावेत

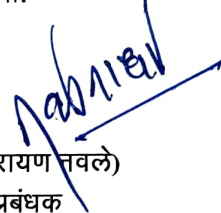
